



Results

KANPE, with its Haitian partners, supports families and their communities by strengthening the essential pillars for autonomy: health, nutrition, agriculture, education, entrepreneurship and leadership.

To this date, 550 female heads of families and 250 farmers have benefited from the support of KANPE towards financial autonomy.

Sustainable Results

— Until 2017, KANPE carried out its Family Support Program in partnership with a private Canadian foundation, enabling 550 families to lift themselves out of poverty through the establishment of microenterprises. This program was established thanks to the support of partners in Haiti.

One year after the first 330 families graduated from the program, more than 97% had maintained two sustainable sources of income, enabling them to provide for their families and send their children to school.

Thanks to the creation of these microenterprises, each family had an average of \$500 CAD of savings, and school enrollment rose from 31% to 87%.

— The 70 young people who make up the local marching band have started to make money by performing at parties, weddings, and funerals in the area. They are the pride of the community.

Where donations go, our concrete actions:

Health & Nutrition

- A medical clinic serving over 11,000 residents. We recorded more than 53,000 visits since opening in 2011.
- More than 1,700 cases of cholera have been treated since 2011.
- More than 1,000 Malaria tests are performed each year.
- Distribution of a basic water purification system to 550 families has been achieved.
- An average of 150 consultations/month are provided to pregnant women.
- In 2018, January through June, more than 90 children affected by malnutrition have been cured by Nutrition Services.

Agriculture

- Distribution of bean seeds to 250 farmers.
- Distribution of nearly 3,300 farm animals.
- Production of 12,000 fruit and forest seedlings (Reforestation campaign).
- Training in basic accounting for members of the local Farmer's Association.
- Training in soil and water conservation techniques.
- Training in compost production technique and natural insecticides.



Education

- Support of 13 schools in Baille Tourible.
- Construction of two permanent shelters to accommodate small schools.
- Teacher training.

Entrepreneurship

- 550 female heads of household were supported on their path towards autonomy through, notably, the establishment of microenterprises.
- Support for local organizations through: organizational development, organizational strengthening, basic accounting and management.

Leadership

- Creation of a marching band for 70 young students from Baille Tourible. They have started to generate revenue by being hired to perform at parties, weddings and funerals in the area.
- Summer camp for 94 teenagers: 10 days of workshops and discussions on subjects such as deforestation, agriculture, illiteracy, youth exodus, teenage pregnancy...
- Civic engagement activities for the youth at large: environmental issues, agriculture, health, education and human rights.

Local Infrastructure Strengthening

- Renovation of the cholera treatment unit of the clinic.
- Construction of a silo to store the crops of the community.
- Construction of a kitchen for the school canteen of the national school.
