



2019 Results

In collaboration with its Haitian partners, The KANPE Foundation supports families and their communities as they work to achieve autonomy by strengthening six essential pillars: health and nutrition, agriculture, education, entrepreneurship, leadership, and improvement of local infrastructure.

Following our mission, here are our 2019 on-site result-driven achievements:

HEALTH AND NUTRITION

Local Haitian partner Zanmi Lasante

Care and prevention services offered to over 11,000 residents of Baille Tourible (people from neighboring communities almost double that number). Available data for 2019 shows how the clinic has offered daily care through its various services:

- Consultations (monthly average of 980).
- Lab tests (monthly average of 320).
- Free distribution of medication.
- Treatment of severe or moderate malnutrition (annual average of 170 children).
- No new cases of cholera in 2019.
- Prenatal consultations (monthly average of 120 families) and deliveries (annual average of 30).
- Family planning services (annual average of 800 people).
- Training in health education offered to the population and young people in the areas of reproductive health, personal hygiene, environmental health, childcare, and STD/STI/HIV prevention.
- Transportation services for patients, members of the medical team, and medications.
- 20 jobs maintained at the clinic including: general practitioner, nursing assistants, assistant pharmacists, assistant social worker, primary care nurses, medical technologists.

LEADERSHIP & ENTREPRENEURSHIP

- Support for the creation and reinforcement of a committee of young leaders of Baille Tourible, including: 1 doctor, 2 auxiliary nurses, 3 teachers and 1 agronomist.
- Continued support to the ODB farmers' association: good governance, organizational development and reinforcement, management and basic accounting.
- Leadership, environment and civic responsibility training for the youth of the marching band.
- Organization and implementation of a summer camp for 86 teenagers including: instruction in agriculture, health, music, painting, drawing and macramé.
- Logistical and financial support for the organization of cultural and sports activities as part of the Baille Tourible Patronal Feast and the Flag Day Festival.



AGRICULTURE AND ENVIRONMENT

Local Haitian partner Mouvement Paysan Papaye

- Acquisition of the land for construction of an experimental farm in 2020.
- Production of 2 annual harvests of beans, planting of 3,000 fruit trees and 7,000 forest trees and implementation of a goat farm project by the farmers' association (ODB).
- Development of a nursery producing 2,000 acacias, 1,500 cedars and 700 lemon trees by the 70 high school students.
- Training in agriculture for the 86 young people enrolled in the summer camp.
- Integration of agricultural and livestock related activities into the high school curriculum for the students.
- Active participation of the 84 young people of the marching band in reforestation days and implementation of monthly waste collection activities.
- March for climate by the marching band youth on September 27, 2019, taking part in the worldwide Fridays For The Future movement launched by young activist Greta Thunberg. The message of the event was retweeted by the activist.

EDUCATION

Local Haitian partner Summits Education

- Support for the management of the public primary school, allowing:
 - the preparation and distribution of hot meals to 450 students,
 - continuing education for the teachers,
 - building maintenance.
- Purchase and distribution of: 394 school bags with complete sets of school materials, 4,250 textbooks required for teaching the first 9 years of the school cycle, and 20 teacher's guides to support teachers in their class preparations.

LOCAL INFRASTRUCTURES STRENGTHENING

- Major renovation of the public primary school: construction of a common wall, installation of fences, repair of new floors, repair and painting of all walls, construction of a drainage channel, the installation of gutters.
- Construction of a storage unit for 105 musical instruments and a small office for the music teacher.
